Tēnā Koutou, I am pleased to be able to provide a positive update on the work underway to enable us to begin the restoration of Mamaku/Section 9. With the support of Tiakina te Taiao and funding from Tasman District Council, a price reduction from NZTA and the approval from the Land Acquisition Fund; the Department is in the final stages of purchasing the Mamaku/Section 9 as a local purpose (cultural and ecological restoration) reserve.
