MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MAPUA AND DISTRICTS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION AND OWNERS OF AEDS ACCESSIBLE TO THE MAPUA COMMUNITY

There are a number of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) in the Mapua community that are available to the public. These are privately owned but the Mapua and Districts Community Association (MDCA) has undertaken to monitor and maintain them. The relationship between the MDCA and the AED owners is as follows:

Ownership will remain with those people or businesses that purchased the AEDs.

Insurance cover remains an option for the owners but will not be covered by MDCA.

- Local St Johns have no knowledge of vandalism of AEDs and they do audibly beep when the cabinet is opened.

Monitoring the batteries and pads and the integrity of these AEDs will be carried out routinely by the MDCA AED Subcommittee.

- The expiry date of batteries is recorded and batteries and pads will be replaced after any use of the AED if indicated by the self monitor.

The dropoff point for AEDs that have been used during a resuscitation event is the **Mapua Health Centre**, 62 Aranui Road, Mapua.

- MDCA will maintain a fund for the replacement of batteries and pads
- Each AED has a tag advising the dropoff point post use.
