Confirming that I am happy to prepare a video for the MDCA meeting and can join via Zoom to answer questions. I will just speak about the existing projects as I think it is better if we wait to discuss Richard's letter regarding the sea wall and storm water issues until things are more settled.

A brief update is that Donaldsons have filled in all open trenches and have made the sites safe. Traffic management controls will need to remain in place as they weren't able to seal the road in the section of trenches they were working on in the short time available. Donaldsons will arrange for someone to check the traffic controls daily to check that all is safe.
