PRESENTATION SLOT.

- 1. **Flooding at Mapua School.** Mike Shruer spoke, covering the background causes contributing to the current problems. These included incorrectly installed gully traps vulnerable to the diversion of storm water and upgrading the capacity of some pumping stations. Mike then handed over to Juliet Westbury to explain more of the detail of how the TDC are dealing with the problems. Juliet finished by talking of recent pump blockages in the Mapua area, noting mentioned flushable wet wipes as a major contributing factor, with a plea to the community to please not place these down the toilets. Mike and Juliet then answered questions from the floor.
- 2. **TDC Waterfront Options.** Lindsay McKenzie opened the discussion then handed over to Catherine McFaul who outlined some background to the TDC review and subsequent range of proposed options which are now attracting submissions which close on 14th August. Catherine then handed over to Sharon Flood who outlined the submission process, noting that the TDC will have an information tent at the wharf precinct on 29th July 10am 12.30. Possibly at the hall if wet. Sharon then introduced other councillors and TDC staff (as listed above). Members were then invited to stand and speak. Lindsay McKenzie answered a question about the RMA. Wayne then thanked the TDC for their attendance and the meeting took a 5 minute break while TDC staff and some other attendees left. NOTED: The TDC website is now open until 14 August for submissions on Waterfront options. MDCA to prepare their own submission on 14th August but members were urged to submit their own personal feedback.
