Hi Aileen,

We have recently changed maintenance contractors from Fulton Hogan to Downer. Downer have subcontracted both mowing and spraying to GSL.

GSL have completed one round of mowing. Due to the very wet spring, growth has not tapered off. GSL are programmed to complete a second mow before Christmas.

This is a horizontal mow, cutting 1.5 metres wide from the edge of seal.

GSL will also be completing a vertical cut, but this is programmed for next year.

I would prefer this cut to be sooner than this, and have compiled a large list of obscured

signs and trees in sight lines to present to Downer at the contract meeting next week.

I am on their case Aileen, and expect improvements in the near future.
