### Operations Update

7.12 Inflow and Infiltration - Due to the volume of stormwater and groundwater entering the new wastewater network in Mapua Rise, staff have installed Differential Temperature Sensing (DTS) monitoring equipment. Once this investigation has been completed the properties with stormwater/groundwater discharging to the wastewater network will be identified. Letters will

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be sent to the property owners requiring them to complete remedial works within 60 days. Three properties in Upper Takaka have been identified discharging excessive volumes of wastewater following storm events and at other times from groundwater infiltration. We have written to the property owners asking them to complete remedial works by 27 July 2018.

7.14 The Mapua Leisure Park pump station upgrade and repairs were completed on 10 May 2018 and the new pumps are operating trouble free.

# Ruby Bay

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8.62 The sea wall that is maintained by the Council from 50 metres north of Tait Street through to the Talleys wall to the south (an approximate length of 1100 metres) and which was

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over topped from the Fehi ex-cyclone event, has been repaired to a similar standard to that of the pre-cyclone events.
