Hi Wayne, We do undertake "Welcome" signage. In Motueka they built the stone walls, but this was funded mainly by the MCB.

In Marahau and some other townships, we have installed "Welcome" signage with a host of Motorist services available. In Richmond we have Welcome to signage and in Maori on Lower Queen, these signs are small due to the over-head High Voltage wires.

In the case of Mapua this could be included in the Speed limit thresh-hold signs if not already. We would also like to provide directional signage for the Wharf area however the hold-up has been the naming of the Wharf area which I'm not sure if this has been confirmed. This sign could not be included under the speed limit signage.
