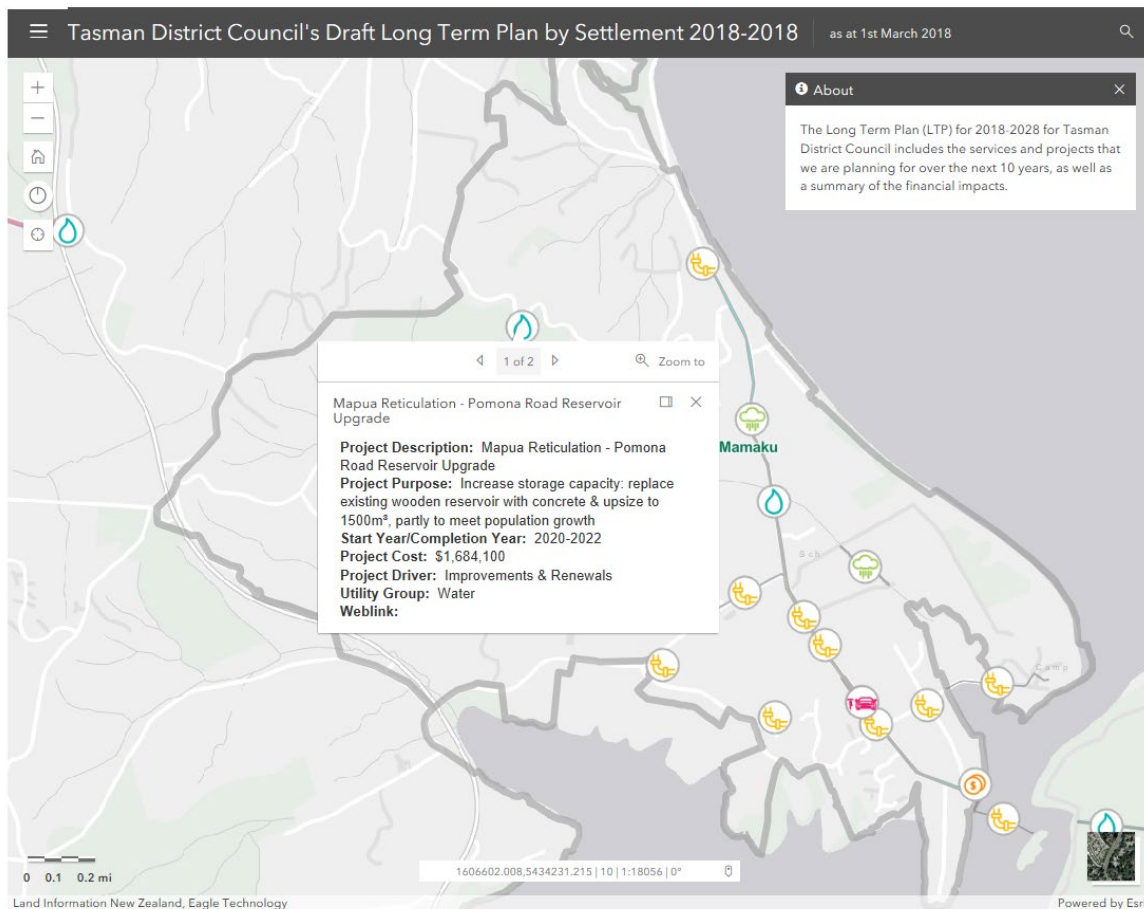
Thanks for inviting me along to the community meeting on Monday. Hopefully we will have some good news about a contract award soon.
