The Appleshed AED was used recently and Debbie from the Jellyfish put things back together with Maggie's help. The glass proved difficult to position and slipped through and broke. I have got some more glass and 2 spare keys so Debbie and I replaced the glass using double-sided tape and locked the Shock Box up.

I have given Anita a spare key and she is available during normal hours at the Hall Reception. I hold the other spare key.

The MDCA has been asked to get an AED for the Ruby Bay area and I have set up a Givealittle page to raise the \$2700 required to get a cut price device from Jennian Homes (http://www.givealittle.co.nz/cause/funding -an- aed-for-ruby-bay)

I will install this device between the Takeaway and the Hairdresser in Ruby Bay when we raise the funds (let friends in Ruby Bay know). This device will serve residents between Cushlas and the Tasman Store.
