Hi Marion,

Thank you for your message. So far we have only discussed the tables and seats conceptually. I have attached the photos that we have discussed with the working group plus one of the Richmond library seating design which I like too.

The concept is for natural timbers to compliment the wharf timbers theme and family friendly for casual use.

I have included a photo of the seating outside Richmond library because it's a very versatile design with options how they can be used. I am interested in developing this idea but using timber framing instead of steel if possible.

I've just had two more made for Thorp Bush in Motueka and they cost \$6000 each using steel frames and Kwilia timber. We would have room for two of this design in the concrete area beside the Ngaio tree which is 12 m across.

On the layout plan the low seats/tables on the grass area are 1200 x 1200mm, the picnic tables are shown at 2400 x 1200mm and the bench seats are 2400 x 500 mm.

I am away on leave next week but on my return I'm very happy to meet and firm up the designs with you.
