

November Roads and Footpaths Report

Roads and Footpaths:

It has been confirmed that the footpath from Mapua Drive to Mamaku Drive is #2 on the TDC priority list and will be completed this financial year.

The RoW to the Mapua Bowling Club has been tidied up but it serves the Cricket Club and Domain visitors with up to 80 cars jammed in at times. With this in mind the TDC has been asked to consider sealing the RoW and carpark. The response was that it would be a major capital works programme. Work is to be carried out on the drainage within the next 6 months which may help. Also, the Reserve Management plans are due for review in 2020 and this would be an opportunity to promote the sealing project.

The new pathway across the Moreland Reserve from Moreland Place and along the completed part of the Aranui subdivision has been completed. This includes the crossing over the Morely Drain and a well formed pathway from there to the Bone's Driveway. We will continue to promote the completion of the pathway from Bones Driveway to the Old Mill Pathway.
