Hello Dear Hall Community,

The launch will give an overview of "Project Drawdown" which is a leading resource for information and insights about climate change solutions and then showcase examples of carbon reducing activities and lifestyles in our region. It starts with a virtual tour across eight participating properties and some community projects. The presentation will cover sustainable food production, food storage and preservation, treatment of biodegradable waste, renewable energy, building with recycled materials and much, much more.

In September and October there are three site tours planned and there will be an opportunity to visit eight local properties. All tours will be guided by site hosts. The ticket sales for the site tours will open on the evening of the 16th of September at the Humanitix website (see above).
