Thank you to you and the Māpua & Districts Community Association for providing feedback on our 2020 Vision for Tasman Long Term Plan (LTP) early engagement document. We received feedback from over 220 people and groups who let us know what they considered was important for the District over for the next 10 years.

The projects and suggestions in your feedback are being considered as we develop the activity management plans, associated budgets, and draft the LTP consultation document. Council acknowledges that due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and the raft of new Central Government requirements, it faces a number of challenges. This is especially with the required work programme including maintenance and renewals and the current economic environment. As a result, we are expecting there to be significant pressure on the LTP 2021 – 2031 budgets and our current rates and debt financial limits.

Formal consultation and hearings on the proposals for our LTP are planned next year in March/April. At that time there will be opportunity for the Community Association to make a formal submission as well as speak to its submission. Formal decisions are expected to be made at the end of June 2021 when the LTP 2021 – 2031 will be formally adopted.
