Mōrena all,

Confirming the projected timelines will be one of the first things we aim to do once the Steering Committee is established. As discussed below, the Council report does note a 2023 Q3 timeline for completion of all steps in the programme, which included the submissions/hearings process and adoption by the Strategy & Policy Committee. However, as Paul noted, I tempered that expectation somewhat during the Waterfront working group meeting (sorry Anna, your faith in me was misplaced). This was also based partially on feedback received during the full Council meeting at which the Māpua Masterplan was approved to proceed, where the timeline was noted to be pretty ambitious.

Producing a draft Masterplan by 2023 Q3 (or slightly into Q4, say Oct or Nov) is achievable and is our current goal. My thought was that sending the draft Masterplan through the public submissions process, holding a hearing, and preparing a final plan fit for adoption may extend that timeline into 2024, all depending on how smoothly the draft comes together and a host of other variables which will eventuate over the year. We have also planned a robust public and iwi engagement process for the Masterplan, and timelines for completing this process effectively are highly unpredictable. Better to do it right than to rush it!

I may not have explained all that well in the Waterfront group meeting, and I apologise for the confusion this has caused. I also want to emphasise again that discussing and confirming these timelines will be top of the agenda for our first Steering Committee meeting.
