Here are the questions being asked of TDC as a result of two lengthy discussions at last night's MDCA meeting.

1. MDCA payment for information re Wastewater discharge into the Mapua Estuary

- Why is a Community Assn being asked to pay for information that impacts the community?
- Why is this information not available by spreadsheet and at the click of a computer button?
- Isn't it a Councillor's role to work in the best interests of the community?
- confirm that Councillors are members of the Environment and Regulatory committee of the TDC and that, given that the TDC management reported on the wastewater system to the committee as per the published minutes of the committee meetings, then Councillors should be able to request the information from the TDC management that the MDCA had requested in the OIA

2. Regarding the legal challenge with Deferred zoning

- Does the land in deferred zones have to be set back to the original zoning prior to the deferment being placed on it?
- What is the current zoning of 166 Mapua Drive?
- How will the pending legal action impact on the MMP timeline?
