Investigation of Road Surface

Dear Resident,

On behalf of Waka Kotahi, NZ Transport Agency, Fulton Hogan will be undertaking investigations on **State Highway 60**, at **High Street** between **Tudor Street** and **Woodlands Avenue**. The work to inspect the road surface and extract samples is in preparation for future road re-construction work. This is part of our annual maintenance programme to keep our state highways safe and is planned, weather dependent as follows:

Wednesday night, 12th of July, 2023

How will this work affect you?

During the work the road will be reduced to one lane between **8:00PM** and **5:00AM** with **30km/hr temporary** speed restrictions and **Stop/Go** traffic lights in place. Please keep to this limit to protect our crews working on the road.

Neighbours may experience noise and vibration while the work is in place, We will do our best to minimise disruption where possible and appreciate your understanding.

Emergency Services will be accommodated at all times.

For your safety and that of our road crews, please drive carefully, and on behalf of Waka Kotahi, thank you in advance for your patience while we do this important work in your community. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this work may cause you.
