Below is a blurb on the proposed Aranui Disc Golf course and the upcoming pop up event for June 1st

The Nelson Tasman Disc Golf Club will be hosting a "pop up" disc golf day at Aranui Park in Mapua on Sunday June 1st (Kings Birthday Weekend).

The club had this site suggested to it from a local community and club member and the club have been working with the Parks and Reserves Team at Tasman District Council with a view to engaging the community about permanently installing a beginner friendly 9 hole Disc Golf course. The club believes this would be another valuable community asset for Mapua and fits well with Tasman District Councils view of multi use spaces.

Disc Golf is a relatively inexpensive sport to get into and most courses are free to play.

It's also a sport for all ages and abilities and is a great way to get outside and be active while having fun.

Aranui Park is an ideal location for a short, fun and inclusive 9 hole course.

This site will add another link in the progression of players using the current local courses the club has raised thousands of dollars in funds to install and maintains via volunteer working bees of club members at Isel Park (Beginner), Branford Park (Intermediate), Saxton Field (Advanced) and Rabbit Island (Elite)

On the first Sunday of each month the Nelson Tasman Disc Golf Club holds a monthly 'Cup Day' event at one of the local courses where our members compete for club trophies and tags. On June 1st cup day will be held at Aranui Park with club members bringing their own temporary baskets and tee pads to create the proposed course.

Once the club event is complete (around 11am) the course will remain setup till 2pm allowing any interested community members to come down, borrow a disc, have a chat with members of the club for some tips and tricks and try out the proposed course for themselves.

We hope to see you there!
