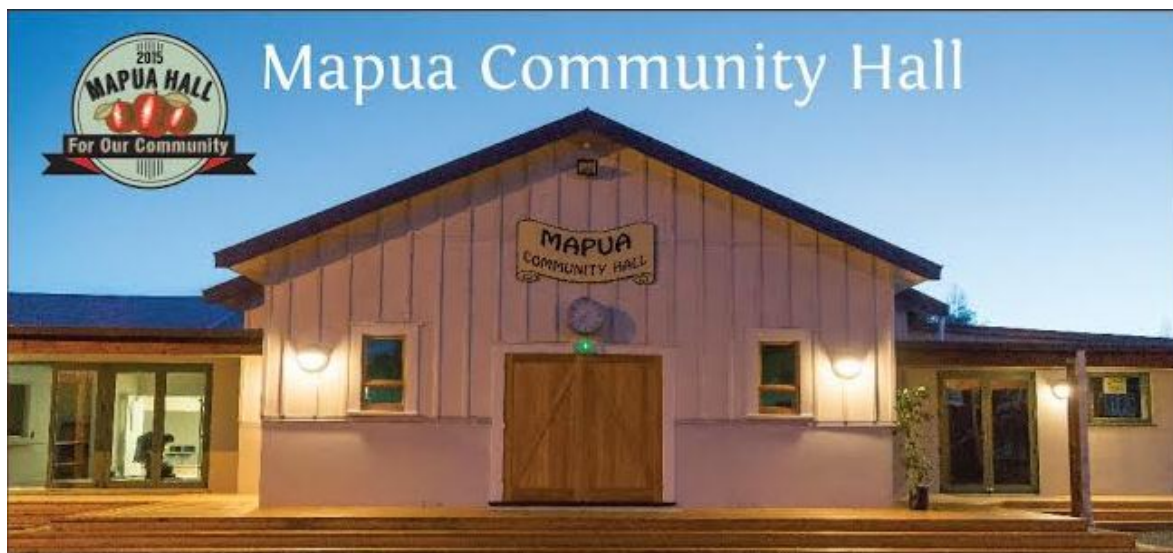

Update on Events at Mapua Hall 2025

I cant believe its already June!

Here's an update for June, as its getting cooler I've had the heat pumps serviced and reset to winter temps. I have changed the Main hall timer from 45 mins to 1hr.

I am still working on the grant for the new heat pump for our meeting room. Please on departing check all doors and windows are closed even if they aren't in your hired hall space. There has been times others have come in and departed through the back doors by the deck and I have found these doors open the next day.

We had an incident Sunday where our kitchenette thermos boiled hot and dry and created a lot of damage to our hall kitchen, 2 fire trucks arrived and we had a practice in our evacuation procedures.

This is a good reminder to make yourself aware of all emergency exists and

make sure these are clear at all times. The gathering area is the car park or the back field. Please make sure no cars are parked in front of the building where access is needed by emergency services.

As you are responsible for the health and safety of your classes, I'd advise allocating a team to support you should an emergency arise, ie someone to check the men's toilets and someone to check the ladies and disabled, someone to assist those with mobility requirements.

You may be aware we were looking at installing a new code lock system for our front door. On further discussion with the providers of the system I don't feel it's suitable for our hall needs, so for now the manual key system will remain in place.
