## SH6 Whakatu Drive – night closures

### What's happening, where and when?



This is to let you know that pavement repairs and installation of a traffic count cable loop will be carried out on State Highway 6 Whakatu Drive.

**Where:** SH6 Whakatu Drive, between Quarantine Road and Link Road roundabouts  
**Start:** Sunday 29 June 2025  
**Finish:** Tuesday 1 July 2025



Work hours: 7pm to 6am

Work nights: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday

### What work will be taking place during this time?

We will carry out routine repairs of the road surface ahead of the wet winter months to prevent water entering the pavement. We will also reinstall traffic counting loops near Songer Street overbridge to help us record traffic volumes and flows.

This is part of the NZ Transport Agency, Waka Kotahi annual maintenance programme to protect our state highways.

### How will this affect my travel plans?



Overnight on Sunday 29, Monday 30 June and Tuesday 1 July, SH6 Whakatu Drive between Quarantine Road and Link Road roundabouts **will be closed** between 7pm and 6am.

Main Road Stoke has been approved for all vehicles and is the recommended detour route for all traffic for the duration of the night closures. The detour route is expected to add approximately 10 minutes to your journey.

There will be noise and vibrations from the construction machinery and some dust.

Outside the closures, traffic management will be removed and the highway will reopen to two lanes.
