SH60 High Street – kerb, channel and footpath replacement

What's happening, where and when?

 This is to let you know that kerb, channel and footpath replacement work on State Highway 60 will begin soon between Inglis Street and Fearon Street.

Where: SH60, High Street, Motueka

Start: Monday 1st September

Finish: Friday 31st October

 Work hours: 7am to 5pm.

Work days: Monday to Friday. No work will take place on weekends or public holidays.

What work will be taking place during this time?

Between Eginton Street and Parker Street, on the western side, and between Inglis Street and Fearon Street, on the eastern side, we will replace the kerb and channel.

Between Inglis Street and Fearon Street, on the eastern site, we will also resurface the footpath.

This work is in preparation for upcoming resurfacing work on the road which will be done in two parts. You will receive a letter closer to the time with further details.

- Stage 1: Tudor Street to Greenwood Street will start in late September and take three weeks.
- Stage 2: Old Wharf Road to Whakarewa Street and Greenwood Street to Fearon Street will start in mid-November and take two weeks.

This is part of the NZ Transport Agency, Waka Kotahi annual seasonal maintenance programme to protect our state highways.

How will this affect my travel plans?

 From Monday 1st September to Friday 31st October, work will start with some sections of the kerb, channel and footpath gated off or have a temporary ramp in place, either while work is underway or while the concrete cures. Some parking spaces on High Street will be unavailable during this time.

Within the work site, driveway access for your home will always be available using ramps. If you have trouble getting to or from your home or business, please don't hesitate to talk to any of the onsite staff, or via the contacts listed below.

Emergency services will always be accommodated.
