SH60 High Street – asphalt resurfacing: Stage 1

What's happening, where and when?

 This is to let you know that we will soon begin our State Highway 60 High Street, Motueka resurfacing programme. This will be carried out in two stages.

Stage 1

Where: SH60, High Street, Motueka

What: Night time asphalting on SH60 between Tudor Street and Greenwood Street

Start: Sunday 28 September, 7pm

Finish: Friday 17 October, 7am

 Work hours: 7pm to 7am.

Work nights: Sunday to Thursday nights. No work on Friday and Saturday nights.

How will this affect my travel plans?

 Southbound road users travelling towards Mapua, will need to detour via Staples Street, Thorp Street and Old Wharf Road. SH60 High Street will remain open for northbound road users travelling towards Riwaka.

For three nights, Sunday 5 October, Monday 6 October and Tuesday 7 October, SH60 High Street Motueka will be closed in both directions between 7pm and 7am, while the Greenwood Street / Pah Street / High Street intersection is resurfaced. During this time, all road users will need to travel via the detour route Staples Street, Thorp Street and Old Wharf Road. Allow an extra five minutes travelling time when using the detour route. The detour route has been temporarily approved for all vehicles.

Outside work hours, please drive with care as there will be an uneven surface.

Emergency services will always be accommodated.

Stage 2 will follow in mid-November when we will chipseal two sections of State Highway 60 between:

- Old Wharf Road and Whakarewa Street
- Greenwood Street to Fearon Street.

This work will take approximately two weeks to complete and will be carried out during the day under stop/go temporary traffic management. You will receive a letter closer to the time with further details.

These works are part of the NZ Transport Agency, Waka Kotahi annual seasonal maintenance programme to protect our state highways.
