SH6 Kohatu – road surface reconstruction

What's happening, where and when?

 This is to let you know that we will be rebuilding a section of State Highway 6 Kohatu-Kawatiri Highway, from the end of the Kohatu Bridge to approximately 700m west of Old School Road.

Where: SH6 RS170 Kohatu
Start: Monday 13th October
Finish: Monday 8th December

 Work hours: 7am to 5pm.
Work days: Monday to Friday. No work will take place on weekends.

What work will be taking place during this time?

The existing road surface will be removed down to a solid foundation. The road will then be rebuilt before new chipseal is applied, to provide a smoother journey for road users.

This is part of the NZ Transport Agency, Waka Kotahi annual seasonal maintenance programme to protect our state highways.

How will this affect my travel plans?

 From Monday 13th October to Monday 8th December, stop/go traffic management with a temporary speed limit of 30km/hr will be in place between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday.

Road users should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Outside work hours, there will be temporary speed restrictions in place due to an uneven surface.

Emergency services will always be accommodated.
