Hi Henk

The main trigger for a proactive road closure is a forecast of over 50mm of rain within a 24 hour period. We generally use Metservice forecasts. More detail shown below.

We do apply judgement to the circumstances or detail of where the rain is expected to fall eg if it is likely to be contained to the western ranges or Richmond ranges, we may not trigger a temporary road closure.
